- 5. SP explained to the GDG the implications and issues with defining 'at risk' factors for women. A distinction will need to be made between universal, selective and indicated risk factors to ensure the relevant analysis of interventions.

- 7. SS presented the results from the initial literature search on antenatal and postnatal terms.
- 8. ES presented a draft economic plan for antenatal and postnatal mental health guideline.
- MM gave a short introduction on how to use the online Guideline Management System. All working documents may be accessed online and GDG members were encouraged to familiarise themselves with the system.
- 10. Four topic groups have been formed to assist the NCCMH team in reviewing the clinical evidence and GDG members volunteered or nominated according to their interests or specialisations.
