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### 1. Welcome, introductions, apologies, declarations of interest and minutes from the previous meeting

DG welcomed the group to the meeting. JS and RF were introduced to the group. JS is the new research fellow and RF is the new work programme coordinator for the guideline. Apologies were given from those listed above. DG asked all the GDG members to declare any relevant conflicts of interest. JA declared a new interest (Co-editor of Child Abuse Review). It was agreed that no interests declared at the meeting or previously warranted exclusion of any GDG members from discussions of evidence or formulation of recommendations. A record of all declarations of interest is held by the NCC-WCH and will be published in the full guideline.

#### 2. Project Update

DG updated the group on the project status and the outcome of meetings between the technical team and NICE guideline methodologists held prior to the GDG meeting. The precise aim for the guideline and methodology of the consensus work were also confirmed.

#### 3. Developing statements about clinical features

JS explained the process for developing recommendations for this guideline. Each clinical feature identified by the GDG will need to be set into context identifying when it should raise the suspicion of maltreatment. The recommendations will then be made on these contextualised clinical features. The GDG was split into groups and each group given a block of clinical features. The groups were then asked to develop contextual statements for their clinical features
