

# IP1848 Transcatheter tricuspid valve annuloplasty for tricuspid regurgitation

**Note**: Due to the structure of ICD-10 it is possible that a diagnosis of tricuspid regurgitation could be classified elsewhere, as final code selection may be affected by additional information documented within the patient's medical record.
