4.1 Have any additional potential equality issues been raised during the consultation, and, if so, how has the Committee addressed them?

One stakeholder commented that women with poor diet, poor social conditions, fewer years of education, on low incomes, from the BAME or refugee communities and with poor health are likely to have an increased risk of preterm birth. However, the guideline does not include information on the risk factors for preterm birth and so this comment did not lead to a change in the recommendations, but it will be flagged to the NICE surveillance team for consideration in future updates.
