1. RB welcomed the group to the second meeting of this guideline development group (GDG). Apologies were received from Diane Todd and Stacia Smales Hill.
2. RB asked the group for any new declarations of interest.
 MM declared:

No other new declarations of interest were received from the GDG members or the other attendees. It was agreed that no interests declared at the meeting or previously warranted exclusion of any GDG members from discussions of evidence or formulation of recommendations at the meeting.

3. Subject to a minor amendment, the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted as an

4. MMu presented the draft review protocol for blood glucose monitoring during pregnancy. The group then discussed the protocol and notes were made live on screen.
 5. EF presented the evidence for contraception – oral hormonal contraceptives (the list of excluded studies, the evidence tables, the evidence profiles and the evidence summary). During the presentations the group had an opportunity to discuss the evidence presented and ask questions. Notes of this discussion were made live on screen. It was agreed that EF will assign some references from the excluded studies list to some GDG members to provide contextual information for the evidence to recommendations section beyond the evidence that is formally included in the review.
 6. MMu presented the draft review protocol for blood glucose target ranges before and during pregnancy. The group then discussed the protocol and notes were made live on screen.
 7. MMu presented the draft review protocol for HbA_{1c} monitoring during pregnancy. The group then discussed the protocol and notes were made live on screen.
 8. MMu presented the draft review protocol for HbA_{1c} target values before and during pregnancy. The group then discussed the protocol and notes were made live on screen.
 9. PJ outlined to the GDG the prospective health economics approach for screening, diagnosis and treatment of gestational diabetes. During the presentations the group had an opportunity to discuss this and ask questions.
 10. CV presented to the GDG the briefing paper from NICE implementation adviser.
 11. AD gave a presentation title “Understanding the Hyperglycemia and Adverse Pregnancy Outcome (HAPO) Study” with the aim to introduce the HAPO study to the GDG. After the presentations the group had an opportunity to discuss this and ask questions.
