



Relatively soon after operation I was able to do all things as before surgery. Eating was immediately possible. Slightly lesser meals ,as stomach slightly smaller. No more reflux . No impact on family

From a point where suicidal thoughts from how ill I had become, not being able to lead a normal life, close family feeling helpless by not able to help. Post operation transformed my life. Normality returned. Social life, hobbies, travel all returned.

It has had such a positive impact on my life after I have had the surgery. I have no symptoms where before I would be throwing up and violently coughing. I would be nervous about eating out, the chance of throwing up in public or work. The medication did help with the symptoms but the minute I would forget one they would come back that same day and I knew I would then be in for a bad day. My children would see me suffer and once when they had a stomach bug broken down about how they did not want to be like me and throw up all the time as they did not like it. Since I have explained to them what I had done and they have had a stomach bug and they did not feel scared that this something they would have every day.

Has significantly reduced/stopped acid reflux. All medication has been stopped. Able to eat pretty much all foods. Absolutely pleased with the results
