Type of analysis	CUA

Population	Adults with bipolar disorder in a stable state
Interventions considered for inclusion	Lithium versus placebo
Type of analysis	Cost analysis

Clinical questions by scope area	Management of acute manic episodes
Population	Adults with bipolar disorder in an acute manic episode
Interventions considered for inclusion	Aripiprazole, asenapine, carbamazepine, haloperidol, lithium, olanzapine, quetiapine, risperidone, valproate
Type of analysis	Cost effectiveness analysis
