3. Nick Meader and Peter Fonagy presented findings from the meta-analyses of early interventions (to prevent/manage conduct problems in children and adolescents), including:
 - Anger management
 - Social skills training (SST) and cognitive problem-solving skills (CPSS)
 - Parent training
 - Functional family therapy (FFT) and brief strategic family therapy (BSFT)
 - Multidimensional interventions.
4. Farheen Jeeva presented a preliminary health economic model for family interventions, and the economic evidence for pre-school interventions.
5. Alan Duncan presented findings from the meta-analyses of pharmacological interventions, mostly targeting impulsive aggression.
