Definitions:

Stakeholders

Individuals or organisations interested in a topic being evaluated by the Diagnostics Assessment Programme, and who register to become a stakeholder. For example, manufacturers of the technology, national organisations that represent healthcare professions who operate or use the result of the technology, National patient or carer organisations, NHS service providers and commissioners, statutory organisations and research organisations.

External Assessment Group (EAG)

An independent academic group commissioned by the NIHR Evaluation, Trials and Studies Coordinating Centre (NETSCC) that prepares a systematic review of the clinical and cost effectiveness of the technology.

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
