

IPG620 - Transaxial interbody lumbosacral fusion for severe chronic low back pain

The mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

Procedure:

OPCS-4 code(s):

V33.3 Primary anterior excision of lumbar intervertebral disc and interbody fusion of other joint of lumbar spine

V55. 1 One level of spine

Y53.4 Approach to organ under fluoroscopic control

Z67.6 Lumbosacral joint

Note: Additional codes may be assigned to classify supplemental posterior instrumentation to provide additional stabilisation and vertebral body spinal fusion of other levels with alternative approaches. Code assignment is dependent on the type of instrumentation/stabilisation or the type of vertebral body spinal fusion and approaches used.

Note: It is not possible to demonstrate that a transaxial approach was used during this procedure using OPCS-4 codes.
