

IP1824 - Prophylactic or therapeutic use of endoanchoring systems in endovascular aortic aneurysm repair

The mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

Procedure:

OPCS-4 code(s):

Endoanchoring systems are not classifiable within OPCS-4 and the securing of a stent graft into place during an endovascular aneurysm repair (EVAR), is considered part of the EVAR procedure.

In instances where a patient returns to theatre to treat a postprocedural stent graft migration or endoleak, the following OPCS-4 codes are recommended:

L26.8 Other specified transluminal operations on aorta

Y15.- Attention to stent in organ NOC

Includes: Attention to stent graft in organ NOC
