

IP1882 Transcatheter tricuspid valve leaflet repair for tricuspid regurgitation

The mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

Y76.8 Other specified minimal access to other body cavity (Based on information that this procedure is performed using femoral or jugular vein approach)

Y07.2 Clipping of organ NOC

Y53.4 Approach to organ under fluoroscopic control

U20.2 Transoesophageal echocardiography

Diagnosis or health condition:

ICD-10 code(s):

I07.1 Tricuspid insufficiency

Or

I36.1 Nonrheumatic tricuspid (valve) insufficiency

Note: Due to the structure of ICD-10 it is possible that a diagnosis of tricuspid regurgitation could be classified elsewhere, as final code as code selection may be affected by additional information documented within the patient's medical record.
