

IP2009 - Bicaval valve implantation for tricuspid regurgitation

- Z39.2 Inferior vena cava**
- U20.2 Transoesophageal echocardiography (if used)**

I07.1 Tricuspid insufficiency

Or

I36.1 Nonrheumatic tricuspid (valve) insufficiency
