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Information provision (women at high risk of adverse outcomes for themselves and/or their baby because of existing maternal medical conditions)

Review question

What are the main areas of information about labour and birth that are needed by pregnant women with existing medical conditions?

Introduction

The overarching aim of this review is to determine what information makes a positive difference to women with existing medical conditions and their babies. This includes giving edited information and how clinical teams' decisions are conveyed to women and their birth companions. There are two sub-objectives:

- to explore the areas of information that would make a positive difference to women and their birth companions
- to evaluate the effectiveness of various information strategies or packages.

Areas of information, and information strategies or packages, to be included in the review will be relevant to quality of care in the intrapartum period (although they may be discussed or implemented in the antenatal, intrapartum or postnatal period). The review will consider women's reports of the information they would have liked to have received and what information would have been helpful for their families.

Summary of the protocol

Clinical evidence

Included studies

One qualitative study among women with acquired or inherited thrombophilia was included in this review (see ‘Summary of clinical studies included in the evidence review’). This study (Martens 2007) was relevant for sub-objective 1. Semi-structured interviews were used to investigate women’s experiences in the study.

Evidence from the studies included in the review is summarised below (see ‘Quality assessment of clinical studies included in the evidence review’).

There was no evidence identified for sub-objective 2 (quantitative review). Also, there was no evidence identified for any other population of interest (women with cardiac disease, asthma, long-term steroid medication, a history of intracranial haemorrhage or a cerebrovascular malformation, acute kidney injury or chronic kidney disease, or obesity).

Included studies

No economic modelling was undertaken for this review because the committee agreed that other topics were higher priorities for economic evaluation (see Supplement 2 (Health economics)).

Evidence statements

Women with thrombophilia

Qualitative evidence for theme 1 – uncertainty regarding birth

Moderate quality evidence from 1 qualitative study identified that women with thrombophilia were uncertain about the risks of discontinuing heparin at the time of birth, and the consequences of starting spontaneous labour without discontinuing their injections.

The committee's discussion of the evidence

Interpreting the evidence

The outcomes that matter most

Outcomes for the woman and the baby were prioritised for the review as the committee determined that both were important and could be affected by information provision.

For sub-objective 1 (qualitative evidence), the committee agreed to be guided on which outcomes to prioritise by evidence emerging from included studies.

For sub-objective 2 (quantitative evidence), the committee considered mortality and major morbidities of both women and babies as critical outcomes because these are life-altering and potentially preventable with good information provision.

The committee also included women's satisfaction with labour and birth, their psychological outcomes and their satisfaction and views of care as important but not critical outcomes. These outcomes can assess the gap between service provision and women's expectations, and can therefore be used as proxies for effective antenatal information provision, as well as being important as an end in themselves.

The quality of the evidence

One qualitative study was included in this review. One limitation of the study was that it included only women with thrombophilia and is therefore not representative of the wider population of interest. Furthermore, the relationship between the researcher and the participants was unclear. On the other hand, the findings were coherent, and the data were

collected in Canada, and hence likely to be of some relevance to the NHS. Thus, overall GRADE-CERQual quality of the studies was appraised as moderate. However, the committee commented that the evidence was very scarce, and decided it was more appropriate to make recommendations based on their experience.

The committee determined that it was not appropriate to recommend randomised quantitative trials in this area because it was difficult to imagine a situation of clinical equipoise with respect to the group receiving less information. The committee also agreed that while it might be appropriate to conduct further qualitative research with these groups of women, the information the committee identified did not contradict the qualitative evidence from the NICE guideline on [intrapartum care for healthy women and babies](#) (CG190) and therefore the committee concluded that additional research on the qualitative information needs of women and babies at high risk in the intrapartum period because of existing maternal medical conditions might be of limited value compared to other questions that could be addressed qualitatively. Consequently they did not make any recommendations for further research.

Benefits and harms

The committee determined that it was important to provide women with medical conditions with information about the intrapartum period, and especially about intrapartum-related reasons why the birth could be different to that of healthy women. The committee added that routine information about the intrapartum period should not be forgotten, and that the NICE guideline on [intrapartum care for healthy women and babies](#) (CG190) was an appropriate source of information. The benefit of providing such information is to allow for shared decision making, and ensure that the woman fully consents to any changes to the management of her condition during the intrapartum period. In addition, information should be shared in line with the NICE guideline on [patient experience in adult NHS services](#) (CG138).

The NICE guideline on [patient experience in adult NHS services](#) (CG138) recommends clarifying with the patient at the first point of contact whether and how they would like their partner, family members or carers to be involved in key decisions about the management of their condition, stating that this should be reviewed regularly and, if the patient agrees, information should be shared with their partner, family members or carers. The guideline also states that if the patient cannot indicate their agreement to share information, those providing care should keep family members or carers involved and appropriately informed, but should be mindful of any potentially sensitive issues and the duty of confidentiality. The committee agreed that it is up to the woman to decide whether and how her birth companion(s) are involved in discussions about her care during labour and birth, so they recommended clarifying with women how they would like their birth companion(s) involved in these discussions, and to review this regularly.

As one purpose of providing information is to allow the woman to make decisions about her care, the committee determined that it was better to provide the information as early as possible in order to allow the woman the longest possible time to make decisions, and to make alterations to the birth plan in response to the decisions if needed. Providing information early also has the advantage of allowing the woman time to ask follow-up questions, and to review the information provided regularly. Finally providing information early is important as high-risk conditions might increase the risk of a preterm birth (either spontaneously or because of a clinical decision taken to manage the risk to the woman). The committee explained that for some conditions (for example, some neurological conditions or long-term haematological conditions), an approximate understanding of impact on the

intrapartum period can be discussed before the woman becomes pregnant, and this should be done if possible.

The committee was aware that information about the intrapartum period was sometimes given to healthy women by a variety of healthcare professionals, for example, a nurse or midwife with no other clinical obligations towards the woman. They determined that this was inappropriate for women with a high-risk intrapartum period, since the woman's care would be managed by a multidisciplinary team, and therefore information about the woman's care needed to come from a member of the multidisciplinary team with sufficient contact with the woman and the team to explain why a particular course of action was recommended and capable of answering questions from the woman on either the intrapartum period or her medical condition.

The committee discussed how information provision would be more challenging if the woman had not had any antenatal care, since it would make it more difficult to discuss the information with the woman and respond to her preferences for labour and birth after sharing the information. The committee recommended that the same principles should be applied to women who have not received antenatal care, but accepted that it would not always be possible to follow every recommendation. Consequently women with no antenatal care should still receive a good quality of information as early as possible, but may have less opportunity to make decisions about their care in light of that information (for example, depending on the stage of labour at which the woman presents it may not be possible to offer a caesarean section).

Cost effectiveness and resource use

The evidence was very limited and the committee made a qualitative assessment of cost effectiveness. They noted that their recommendations on information provision were generally not resource intensive, although they recognised that staff time would be required.

The committee considered that it would be cost effective to provide women with existing medical conditions information about the intrapartum period and in a timely manner, in order to facilitate an informed decision with respect to the woman's choices and potential modifications to the birth plan. The committee considered that this would have a beneficial impact on psychological outcomes and the woman's satisfaction with labour and birth.

The committee considered that their recommendations largely reflected current practice and, therefore, they did not anticipate a significant resource impact to the NHS. However, they thought that for some centres longer consultations might be necessary.

Other factors the committee took into account

The committee discussed that information provision would be challenging for women who had difficulty with communication, for example, women who spoke English as a second language (or not at all), women with a learning difficulty and women with a speech and language impairment. The committee determined that it was not necessary to make a specific recommendation for sharing information with this group, as NICE's existing recommendations on services are explicit in ensuring that communication with the woman acknowledges the importance of factors making communication difficult.

Despite the limited evidence, the committee decided to prioritise other areas addressed by the guideline for future research and therefore made no research recommendations regarding information provision.

The committee was aware that NICE had published a guideline on [diabetes in pregnancy](#) (NG3), which was not otherwise cross-referenced in the guideline recommendations, and so they signposted this after the recommendations about information for women with existing medical conditions.

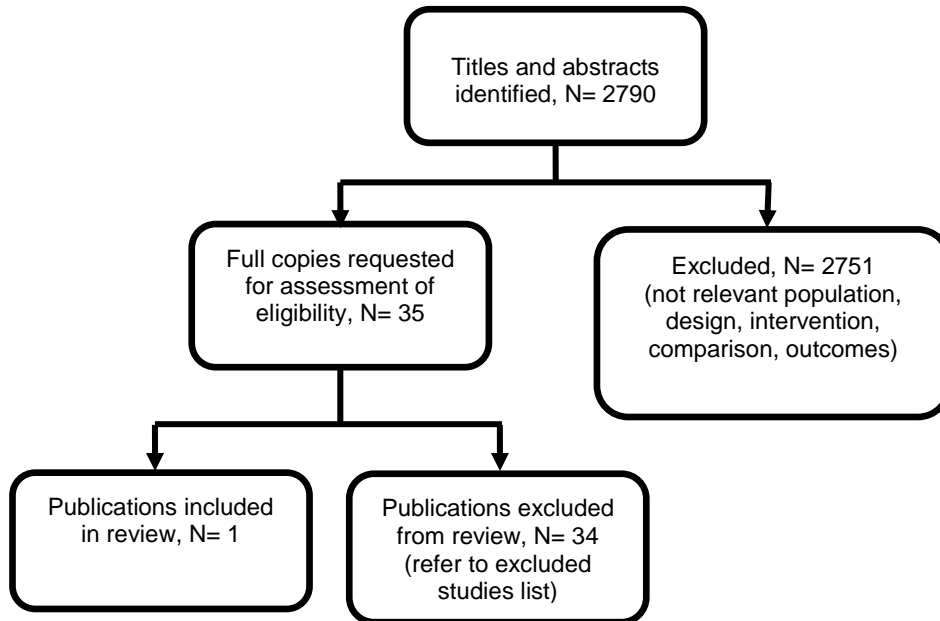
