Sign-off on protocol: PTLB

PTLB: What is the clinical effectiveness of prophylactic progesterone (vaginal or oral) in preventing preterm labour in pregnant women considered to be at risk of preterm labour and birth?

Revised hypertension in pregnancy guideline

Due to a lack of time it was agreed that the edits to previous recommendations for HipQ3 and HipQ6 would be circulated by email.

Hypertension in pregnancy: the NICE pathway

Linda Grainger and Anna Sparshatt (NICE Digital Pathway Editors) presented the NICE pathway development on Hypertension in pregnancy and asked the committee for volunteers who want to help NICE with developing NICE digital pathway on Hypertension in pregnancy

Eva Gonzalez-Viana presented the evidence review for question EP2: How effective is expectant management compared to medical management for ectopic pregnancy?
