1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

4. Presentations

Nathan Bromham, NGA Senior Systematic Reviewer, Angela Bennett, NGA Guideline Lead, and Eric Slade, NGA Senior Health Economist presented the evidence report and draft recommendations for review question 1.1 What are the

most effective commissioning and practice models to deliver joined-up health, social care and education services for disabled children and young people with severe complex needs, and 4.1 What combined service delivery models are most effective in meeting the health, social care and education needs (including changing and evolving needs) of disabled children and young people with severe complex needs?

The committee discussed the evidence and agreed on draft recommendations.

Angela Bennett, NGA Guideline Lead, outlined the agreed recommendations for review question 2.1 What are the most effective combined approaches to identifying, assessing and monitoring the health, social care and education needs (including changing needs) of disabled children and young people with severe complex needs?

Katriona O'Donoghue, NGA Systematic Reviewer, Angela Bennett, NGA Guideline Lead, and Eric Slade, NGA Senior Systematic Reviewer, presented the evidence report and draft recommendations for review question 10.1 What combined health, social care and education service delivery arrangements can best provide for the needs of disabled children and young people with severe complex needs on a palliative or advance care plan, and for the needs of their families and carers?
