1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

The Chair welcomed the committee members and attendees to day 1 of the 30th meeting of the multiple obstetric guidelines update.

The Chair outlined the objectives of the meeting, which included reviewing guideline evidence, discussing re-run searches, making editorial changes to existing recommendations and reviewing current recommendations.

The Chair confirmed that, for the purpose of managing conflicts of interest, the matters under discussion were multiple obstetric topics including Intrapartum care (IPC).

The Chair introduced Rebecca Blackburn, Assistant Systematic Reviewer, who presented the evidence for IPC8.4: ‘What is the optimum position to perform cord clamping to maximise outcomes for the baby?’

5. Afternoon presentations

Eva Gonzalez-Viana, Senior Systematic Reviewer led on a discussion with the committee to agree which searches required updates. The committee discussed and made recommendations on updates to be made.

Hilary Eadon, Guideline Lead, led on IPC editorial changes for EU2, EU3, EU4, EU5, EU6.

Clifford Middleton, Commissioning Manager, asked the committee's views on 999/111 call handling of pregnancy emergencies.

6. Questions and discussions

The committee discussed the evidence on the optimum position to perform cord clamping to maximise outcomes for the baby and made a research recommendation.

The committee agreed on removing the terminology 'supervisor of midwives' as this role no longer exists

The committee agreed on editorial changes for the recommendations on planning place of birth to ensure they were consistent with current practice.

The committee agreed changes to clarify wording on recommendations for urgent emergency transfer for obstetric care and the monitoring that should occur during transfer.

The committee agreed editorial changes for information that should be given to women regarding availability of different pain relief options at their planned place of birth.
