1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting.

3. Minutes of last meeting

The Chair asked the committee to confirm the minutes of the last meeting, and the committee confirmed that no changes were required.

4. Morning presentations

The Chair introduced Agnesa Mehmeti, Systematic Reviewer, and Hannah Tebbs, Technical Analyst (Economics), who presented the evidence for IPC 8.3 (updated Cochrane NMA): What is the effectiveness of uterotonics for the prevention of postpartum haemorrhage?

Hannah Tebbs, Health Economist then led the committee through the health economic model for 8.3.

The committee made changes to the recommendations based on this review.

5. Afternoon presentations

The Chair introduced Beatrice Downing, TSU who gave a presentation to the committee on threshold analysis.

The Chair introduced Agnesa Mehmeti, Systematic Reviewer, who presented on re-runs for 8.5: What is the effectiveness of pharmacological treatments for the management of postpartum haemorrhage?

Agnesa Mehmeti, Systematic Reviewer, then presented on 8.1: What are the benefits and risks associated with active management compared to physiological management in the third stage of labour.

The Chair introduced Hilary Eadon, Guideline Lead, who led on the finalisation of the IPC guideline.

6. Questions and discussions

The committee reviewed and made relevant changes to IPC recommendations.

The committee discussed the proposed health economic model for 8.3.

The committee discussed whether there were benefits to running a threshold analysis for the evidence for IPC 8.3.

The committee discussed the new evidence for 8.5 and reviewed and amended recommendations based upon this and previous evidence.

The committee discussed 8.1 and reviewed the side effect profiles of chosen uterotonics.
