## 2 List of modelling questions

<b>Review questions by scope area</b>	How do different approaches to care planning and assessment affect the process of admission to inpatient hospital settings from community or care home setting?
Population	Older people, 65 years and above.
Interventions and comparators considered for inclusion	Geriatric assessment and care vs. usual care; geriatric assessment and care included specialist care provided in a specialist unit; usual care involved the admission to a general ward under non-specialist care.
Perspective	Costs of health and social care in hospital and the community; (NHS and PSS) in addition the impact of unpaid care on cost savings were explored.
Outcomes	Service use outcomes: Admission to residential care, reduction in length of hospital stay.
Type of analysis	Threshold analysis.
Issues to note	This was a simple threshold analysis to inform the likely cost-effectiveness of geriatric assessment and care in the UK context.
