3.	<b>Economics update</b>	MT provided a brief update on the economic analysis work. The results of the next analysis will be presented at the next meeting.	
4.	<b>Review of evidence: Views and experiences of young people and parents/carers (Q4.5.1 &amp; 4.5.2)</b>	<p>NSh presented the evidence for views and experiences of young people and parents/carers. A total of 474 studies were found from the original screening process and from these 24 studies met the inclusion criteria.</p> <p>From the included studies the evidence statements were drafted and were reviewed by the GDG. The GDG also suggested some amendments to the evidence statements.</p>	<b>Action 2: NCC to update evidence statements as suggested by the GDG.</b>
5.	<b>Developing recommendations for Q4.5.1 &amp; Q4.5.2</b>	The GDG were separated into two groups to draft recommendations based on the evidence statements. The drafted recommendations were then shared with everyone in the plenary session.	
6.	<b>Recommendations plenary</b>	<p>The facilitators from each group fed back the drafted recommendations and suggested edits to each recommendation.</p> <p>The NCC will make the changes as suggested by the GDG and will circulate an updated version of the recommendations at the next meeting.</p>	
7.	<b>Expert witness: Transition from children to adult services for young people with type 1 diabetes by Peter Winocour</b>	<p>PW is a consultant physician in diabetes and endocrinology at the East and North Hertfordshire NHS Trust. He attended as an expert witness to provide further information (including case studies) on transition services for young people with type 1 diabetes and what an effective transition service should include.</p> <p>The GDG discussed the information presented but made no recommendations in relation to this topic area. The GDG will re-visit this at a later meeting.</p> <p>The GDG also suggested that it would be useful to look at transition service models for young people with cancer and HG will forward a contact.</p>	<b>Action 3: HG to forward a contact for an expert witness on transition models for young people with cancer.</b>
