REPORTS OF DISCUSSIONS AT THE MEETING

1. Introductions

DL welcomed everyone and thanked them for attending the 6th meeting of the NHL GDG.

An apology for absence was received from Katie Perryman-Ford, Gillian Howard Jones and Ian Chau.

2. Declarations of interest

The following declaration of interest was made prior the meeting:

- KL's department received a medical education grant from Pfizer for £2,000 to commission the development of a patient held diary including design, printing and material costs. This interest was categorised as non-personal pecuniary, non-specific meaning that KL can declare and participate in discussions on all topics as the use of patient held diaries is not being investigated by the guideline.
- KL received an honorarium from Pfizer for attending an Advisory Board on 'Input strategies and materials for educating stakeholders about Pfizer's potential biosimilars and the related development pathways'. This interest was categorised as personal pecuniary, specific meaning that KL must declare and withdraw from discussion on any topics which include Pfizer potential biosimilars until October 2015.

- GC received an honorarium from Takeda for giving a talk to the East of England Blood club on Hodgkin's lymphoma. This interest was categorised as personal pecuniary, non-specific meaning that GC can declare and participate in discussions on all topics as Hodgkin's lymphoma is not being covered by the guideline.

The GDG were reminded that if they take on any new interests, these must be declared to the NCC-C as soon as they happen so that the necessary action can be taken.
