Review questions by scope area	Q5a. What is the acceptability, effectiveness and cost effectiveness of interventions or approaches to improve access and referral to health, social care and housing support services for older people with learning disabilities?
Population	Older people with learning disabilities, 40 years and above
Interventions and comparators considered for inclusion	Intervention: People are offered annual health checks by their GP practice Comparator: Standard care (people are not offered annual health checks by their GP practice)
Perspective	NHS
Outcomes	Health-related quality of life measured in quality-adjusted life years (QALYs)
Type of analysis	Cost utility; decision-analytic modelling; Markov model; probabilistic and one-way sensitivity analysis
Issues to note	This model was explorative in nature due to the many gaps in evidence.
