Please accept my apologies for the late reply in providing comments on the ACD.

The ACD makes reference to a maintenance dose of infliximab as 5mg/kg every 8

weeks. Did the committee or DSU ever consider maintenance dosing above 5mg/kg

every 8 weeks. Other doses are licensed such as 10mg/kg every 8 weeks (5mg/kg

every 4 weeks). I couldn't see reference to it in the ACD or the Evaluation Report. If

the committee or DSU didn't take into consideration higher doses, could they please

do so?
